AWB hopes to bring trauma relief services (the "Medicine of Peace") to communities affected by disasters, human conflict, environmental devastation, poverty and social injustice. We are committed to collaborating with local community-based organizations and treating all who have been affected by traumatic events – survivors, first responders, emergency personnel and other care providers. We offer services and training in local communities with the goal of creating long-term, sustainable benefits after we leave. Our intention is to empower each community we serve in a way that best supports their particular needs for rebuilding and recovery.

What are the institution's activities? When are which activities to be carried out? And how do the activities contribute to achieving the organisation's objective?

We have ongoing clinics throughout the US west coast and Puerto Rico, Mexico, Haiti, Greece, and Israel/Palestine. Our aim is to continue expanding our institutional capacity for deployment to other US states and countries with projects already underway in California, Florida as well as the UK, the Netherlands, Norway, Germany, and Poland. We have also recently been incorporated as an NGO in Greece, where we are leading a refugee program that we hope to expand to other parts of Europe and the Middle East currently experiencing a migration crisis. Due to the offset of the war between Ukraine and Russia, we have expanded our training and community organizing program in Europe to the Netherlands, Norway, Germany, Poland, and the UK. We are continuously adding new focus countries based on the migration flow of refugees and other migrants in the region to be able to meet the needs for trauma-informed care. We have been offering in-person trainings for over a decade and currently offer virtual certified trainings as well. This with the hopes to continue growing the technical capacity to treat and prevent trauma in the acupuncture and mental health fields and, in conjunction with our mobile clinics and projects, reach more communities in need.

1. Program trains acupuncturists nationally and internationally to provide trauma treatment services to survivors of natural and human disasters. Trained approximately 500 acupuncturists in trauma and field protocols, and prepared/mentored them to establish and run trauma-informed care service projects in their communities. Supported field training for 10 local midwives in Mexico to learn trauma reduction treatment methodologies. Provided online and in-person training in Amsterdam on integrative medicine and trauma-informed care to health care practitioners working with refugees and displaced people. Provided live webinars on topics of interest for acupuncturists and health professionals.
2. International clinics: support establishment of community clinics in Haiti, Athens (and surrounding area), Tijuana-Mexico, West Bank/Palestine, EU/UK. Planning a clinic for Antalya Turkey, for refugees/displaced people. Also provide free ear acupuncture for populations affected by traumatic events including refugees, elders, the homeless, and sexual violence/trafficking survivors.
